Clinical results

Die klinische Verwendung von Atlantis Abutments wurde in Fallberichten¹⁻³⁰ und klinischen Studien³¹⁻⁵¹ beschrieben, in denen ästhetische Resultate für Abutments aus Titan^{3-12, 18, 34, 35, 37}, goldfarbenem Titan^{20, 21, 33, 34, 37, 39} und Zirkonoxid^{13-17, 32, 35-38, 45-50} berichtet werden. Die klinische Dokumentation zum Atlantis Abutment berichtet über Wiederherstellung und Erhaltung der Papille^{7, 13, 31, 34, 49, 50}, Schaffung von optimaler Weichgewebekontur und Austrittsprofil^{3, 8, 11, 13}, verbesserte Bewertung der rosafarbenen Ästhetik⁴⁸ und der Patientenzufriedenheit^{7, 19, 32, 35}.

Experimentelle Resultate

Experimentelle Studien berichten über verschiedene Aspekte der Atlantis Abutments⁵²⁻⁶⁶, darunter die ideale Passform zwischen Abutment und Implantat^{52, 53}, die Genauigkeit der Herstellung⁵⁷ und die ideale Passform und Retention von Kappen⁵⁴. Darüber hinaus wurden gute mechanische Eigenschaften, einschließlich Stabilität und Wahrscheinlichkeit, okklusalen Kräften zu widerstehen, für das Atlantis Abutment aus Zirkonoxid berichtet^{57, 60}.

Klinische Vorteile bei der Verwendung von Atlantis® Abutments

Die wissenschaftliche Literatur über individualisierte Atlantis Abutments hat mehrere klinische Vorteile gezeigt, darunter:
